

CLASS RULES***Be Present, Prompt, Prepared, Polite and Positive***

1. Be in class and in your seat on time. Have your materials for that day with you, be quiet and be ready to start work when the bell rings.
2. Follow all instructions the first time they are given.
3. Do not talk unless you raise your hand and I call on you. Exceptions to this guideline will be classroom discussions. However, I expect you to be polite and respect your peers' rights to contribute to the class.
4. Do not talk back, which includes swearing, cursing and general insubordinate behavior.
5. Keep your hands, feet and objects to yourself.
6. Do not leave class until you are dismissed.
7. You may use computer technology only when given permission.
8. School rules will be enforced, such as the tardy policy and dress code, following the procedures set out in the discipline handbook.

SEVERE CLAUSE

1. Hurt anyone in the class deliberately.
2. Refuse to do the work or follow a direction.
3. Destroy school property.
4. Commit any act which upsets or totally paralyzes the class.
